Responsible Handling of Conflict Minerals

REO AG is committed to the responsible and sustainable procurement of raw materials. We support international efforts to prevent the financing of armed conflicts and human rights violations through the mining and trade of certain minerals.

As a manufacturer of high-quality inductive, resistive, and electronic components, we work closely with our suppliers to ensure transparency in the supply chain and to meet the requirements of our customers as well as applicable legal regulations.

Our measures include, in particular:

- Regularly obtaining declarations from our suppliers regarding the origin of conflict-related minerals.
- Assessing the supply chain based on the current requirements of the Responsible Minerals Initiative (RMI).
- Using the standardized reporting formats CMRT (Conflict Minerals Reporting Template) and EMRT (Extended Minerals Reporting Template).
- Supporting our suppliers in implementing responsible raw material sourcing.
- Continuously monitoring regulatory developments and implementing necessary measures.
- Supporting our customers by providing relevant compliance information.

The focus is particularly on the so-called 3TG minerals:

- Tin, tantalum, tungsten, and gold

In addition, in accordance with the current requirements of the Responsible Minerals Initiative, we also take into account other raw materials that are reported via the Extended Minerals Reporting Template (EMRT), in particular:

- Cobalt and mica

REO AG does not operate any mines, smelters, or refineries itself and does not source these raw materials directly. Therefore, we rely on the information provided by our suppliers and are continuously working to further improve transparency within our supply chain.
