Compliance with the RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU

REO AG is committed to complying with the requirements of the RoHS Directive 2011/65/EU and the Delegated Directive (EU) 2015/863 on the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.

As a manufacturer of high-quality inductive, resistive, and electronic components, we place great emphasis on product safety, environmental compatibility, and compliance with all applicable legal requirements. Together with our suppliers, we continuously monitor the materials used and evaluate them against the current RoHS requirements.

Our measures include, in particular:

- Regular review of the applicable RoHS requirements and exemptions.
- Evaluation of our products with regard to permissible substance concentrations in accordance with the RoHS Directive.
- Obtaining and maintaining material declarations and RoHS declarations of conformity from our suppliers.
- Continuous monitoring of legal changes and implementation of necessary measures.
- Supporting our customers by providing relevant compliance information.
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The RoHS Directive specifically restricts the use of the following substances:

- Lead (Pb)
- Mercury (Hg)
- Cadmium (Cd)
- Hexavalent chromium (Cr⁶⁺)
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB)
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE)
- Bis(2-ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP)
- Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP)
- Dibutyl phthalate (DBP)
- Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP)

Where permissible exemptions for specific applications apply in accordance with Annexes III and IV of the RoHS Directive, these will be taken into account during the product evaluation.
