Information Requirements Under the SCIP Database

REO AG supports the objectives of the European Waste Framework Directive (WFD) and complies with the legal information requirements related to the SCIP database of the European Chemicals Agency (ECHA).

As a manufacturer of high-quality inductive, resistive, and electronic components, we place great emphasis on product safety, resource conservation, and transparency throughout the supply chain. Together with our suppliers, we continuously monitor the substances contained in our products and evaluate them in light of the applicable SCIP requirements.

Our measures include, in particular:

- Regular review of the current REACH Candidate List (SVHC).
- Assessing our products with regard to the information requirements under Article 33 of the REACH Regulation.
- Reviewing the SCIP reporting requirements for affected articles.
- Obtaining and maintaining material declarations from our suppliers.
- Continuously monitoring regulatory changes and implementing necessary measures.
- Supporting our customers by providing relevant compliance information.

A notification to the SCIP database is required if an article contains a substance of very high concern (SVHC) from the current REACH Candidate List in a concentration exceeding 0.1% by weight (w/w) and the legal requirements for a reporting obligation are met. Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986) for the U.S. market.

REO AG continuously assesses its products for potential SCIP obligations and, where necessary, provides the relevant information throughout the supply chain.
